1 Corinthians 11:23-34  
July 19, 2020

The first Lord's Supper took place during the feast of \_\_\_\_\_.

During the Exodus, the blood of a spotless lamb was to be applied to the doorposts of the home. At midnight, the death angel would take the firstborn of each household, unless the \_\_\_\_\_ was upon the doorposts.

*"And it came to pass, that at midnight the Lord smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle. And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and there was a great cry in Egypt; for there was not a house where there was not one dead. And he called for Moses and Aaron by night, and said, Rise up, and get you forth from among my people, both ye and the children of Israel; and go, serve the Lord, as ye have said." Exodus 12:29-31*

The Passover feast was a remembrance of God's liberation of the children of Israel from the \_\_\_\_\_ of Egypt.

*"And it shall be when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What is this? that thou shalt say unto him, By strength of hand the Lord brought us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage:" Exodus 13:14*
